Due to the covid-19 pandemic, immediate family has decided to take safety measures for Enid (Doris) Twoyoungmen's funeral service. We are announcing that we will not have any wake services/traditional funeral for the public. Knowing Enid Twoyoungmen has many extended families/loved ones, this was a hard decision to make. The safety of our community is most important to us.

We are having a private service at the funeral home with 48 invitational immediate family to attend. The steps we have taken are screening everyone that are attending for any flu/cold symptoms. We are practicing the advice given from our emergency response team and Alberta health regulations.

We will be having a memorial service for the public in the near future once this pandemic is controlled and when it is safe to do so from Alberta health & emergency response team guidelines.

Please note that if you are not on the list, have not been contacted to attend by the immediate family, the funeral home will not allow anyone to enter their facility unless listed due to the funeral home safety guidelines.
